MS Finnmarken was built in 2002 and last refurbished in 2012. It is the first of the three "Millennium-class" newest Hurtigruten ships, together with Midnatsol and Trollfjord. MS Finnmarken itinerary calendar has sailings between Bergen and Kirkenes, with some departures from Tromsø.

The M.S Finnmarken Hurtigruten has a spectacular Art Nouveau style interior which has been designed by Norwegian artists which combines contemporary design with impeccable service, comfort and wonderful opportunities to enjoy the spectacular scenery. This is the only Hurtigruten ship that features an outdoor swimming pool and Jacuzzi, where you can relax in heated comfort while admiring the view.

MS Finnmarken cruise ship deck plan has a total of 282 staterooms for 628 passengers (max capacity is 1000 guests on Norwegian coastal voyages), served by 75 crew/staff. The Finnmarken's Standard Cabins are comfort-

able and compact and furnished with twin beds. There are several Mini-Suites that include double beds, and spacious Suites with large picture windows and balcony access. There are also a couple of Grand Suites in the bow, which have two rooms and a private balcony and Jacuzzi

## LOFOTEN

Lofoten is known for excellent fishing and nature attractions. Tourists can kayak between the islands, go fishing or look for sea eagles soaring in the sky. This is because Lofoten has a very high density of sea eagles, cormorants and other sea birds. With a distinctive scenery and dramatic mountains, it is definitely a tourist attraction not to be missed.



## BERGEN

The first two Norwegian places to be entered on the List of World Heritage sites. Founded around the year 1000, it is one of the oldest major trading ports of northern Europe. Bryggen is the only trading post outside the Hanseatic Cities that has managed to preserve its original structure of their houses. Inside the houses there was room for accommodation, for offices and for the storage space required for the trade of dried fish.

## KIRKENES

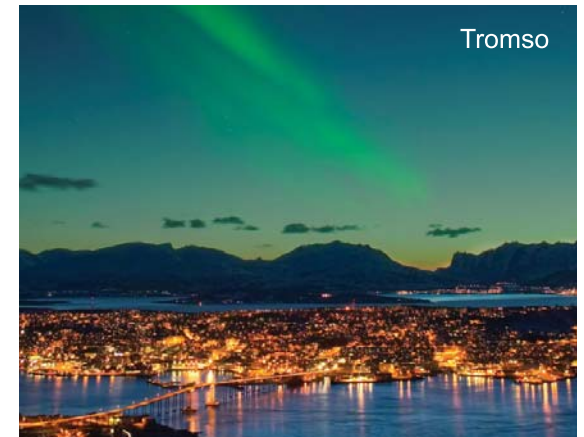
Kirkenes is located in the extreme northeastern part of Norway on the Bøkfjord, a branch of the Varangerfjord, near the Russian border. In winter and spring Kirkenes is the home of a fantastic Kirkenes Snow Hotel, and activities like snow scootering and dog sledding are popular.

## TROMSØ'S

Tromsø's often described as the Paris of the north, enjoy Midnight Concert at Arctic Cathedral will be the most Magical experience. Tromsø is the best location for snow and skies lit up by the northern lights, is perfect for winter activities like dogsledding and skiing.

## TRONDHEIM

Trondheim is known as one of the typical wooden cities of Europe, and the city center has many special wooden buildings. Nidaros Cathedral is the world's northernmost cathedral and Norway's national sanctuary.

1	<b>Depart to Bergen</b>
2	<b>Bergen - Cruise Embarkation</b> Upon arrival, transfer to cruise terminal. Luggage drop off available after 1.00 pm until 2.30 pm. Check in will begin at 3.00 pm and embarkation take place after your attendance of Safety Information Meeting in the terminal building.
3	<b>Alesund</b> After making several brief night time calls along the unspoilt coastline, you reach the delightful town of Alesund which was completely rebuilt in Art Nouveau style having been destroyed by fire in 1904. Here you can enjoy the shore excursion to explore this fascinating location on foot. Leaving Alesund you head north towards Trondheim.
4	<b>Trondheim, the Medieval Capital</b> Continuing north you head for the medieval city of Trondheim, whose colorful history is reflected in its handsome civic architecture.
5	<b>Arctic Circle and Lofoten Islands</b> Cross the Arctic Circle and later in the day you reach the legendary Lofoten Islands, where you can take part in the Lofotr Viking Feast excursion or enjoy an after dinner stroll in Solvaer. Perhaps join the shore excursion to visit the world's first Ice Gallery "Magic Ice" which features dramatically lit ice sculptures and atmospheric music that illustrate tantalising tales about the island and their people.
6	<b>Tromsø, the Gateway to the Arctic</b> Following a relaxing morning on board you arrive mid-afternoon in Tromsø, Norway's arctic capital, a great place to see Northern Light and soak up life high above the Arctic Circle. This is also an ideal location to gain a real taste of the Arctic by joining an optional dog sledging excursion, a truly exhilarating and unforgettable experience.
7	<b>Honningsvåg and the North Cape, Crossing the 71st Parallel</b> After an early call at Hammerfest you arrive in Honningsvåg, the portal to the wonders of the spectacular North Cape, mainland Europe's northernmost point. Evening call at Kjøllefjord where you can join the thrilling Lapland snowmobile excursion.
8	<b>Kirkenes and the Snow Hotel</b> <span style="float: right;">(Dinner at Snow Hotel)</span> Travel to Kirkenes, just a few kilometres from the Russian border. Kirkenes is home to the fantastic Snow Hotel. Transfer for your special Arctic experience to the Snow Hotel, constructed entirely from snow and ice each year and conveniently located for enjoying shore excursion - Husky dog sledging, king crab safari and many others exciting winter activities.
9	<b>Kirkenes - Oslo - Kuala Lumpur</b> <span style="float: right;">(Breakfast at Snow Hotel)</span> After breakfast, transfer to Airport for flight home.
