Trollfjord joined Hurtigruten's fleet in 2002 and belongs to the line's Millennium class of ships -- the most modern ships in the fleet. Of Hurtigruten's 11 vessels, Trollfjord and her sister vessel MS Midnatsol are the two largest plying the coastal route. As such, they're also the most comfortable, offering passengers the most space to spread out onboard, as well as signature features like the two-tiered Panorama lounge and separate Concierge area on Deck 8, where the top suites -- replete with bay windows or large balconies -- are found.

Trollfjord plies the Norwegian coastal waters 365 days a year, transporting passengers and goods to remote coastal villages tucked between the fjords and delighting pleasure passengers with glimpses of coastal life and world-class landscapes. Cruises start in Bergen and end up 1,500 miles north in the town of Kirkenes, near the Russian border, before making their way back down the coast and doing it all over again. Highlights include traveling through the beautiful Lofoten Islands under the glow of

the midnight sun or the northern lights and a visit to North Cape, the northernmost point in Continental Europe.

LOFOTEN

Lofoten is known for excellent fishing and nature attractions. Tourists can kayak between the islands, go fishing or look for sea eagles soaring in the sky. This is because Lofoten has a very high density of sea eagles, cormorants and other sea birds. With a distinctive scenery and dramatic mountains, it is definitely a tourist attraction not to be missed.



BERGEN'S BRYGGEN

The first two Norwegian places to be entered on the List of World Heritage sites. Founded around the year 1000, it is one of the oldest major trading ports of northern Europe. Bryggen is the only trading post outside the Hanseatic Cities that has managed to preserve its original structure of their houses. Inside the houses there was room for accommodation, for offices and for the storage space required for the trade of dried fish.



GEIRANGERFJORD

The deep blue UNESCO-protected Geirangerfjord is surrounded by majestic, snow-covered mountain peaks, wild waterfalls and green vegetation. It is a 15-kilometre long branch off of the Sunnlyvsfjorden and experience the fjords and the waterfalls from one of the many available sightseeing trips or hiking.



VEGA ISLANDS

The UNESCO-protected islands of Vega, is named one of the world's top undiscovered island gems. Located south of the Arctic Circle, the municipality comprises of over 6500 number of islands, reefs and skerries. The main island of the municipality is also called Vega, and it is also the largest at 163 square kilometres.



TROLLFJORD

The narrow Trollfjord is a 2 km long sidearm of the Raftsund between Lofoten islands and Vesteralen archipelago. With its narrow entrance and steep mountain sides, the Trollfjord is truly exotic and spectacular, where the narrow mouth of the Trollfjord is only 100 meters wide and widens to a maximum width of 800 meters.

1	Depart to Bergen via Amsterdam
2	Bergen - Cruise Embarkation Arrive the capital of Norway. Transfer to pier for embarkation. Board your ship in Bergen, leave your everyday life behind and enjoy the ambience of life on board Hurtigruten.
3	Alesund After making several brief night time calls along the unspoilt coastline, you reach the delightful town of Alesund which was completely rebuilt in Art Nouveau style having been destroyed by fire in 1904. Here you can enjoy the shore excursion to explore this fascinating location on foot. Leaving Alesund you head north towards Trondheim.
4	Trondheim, the Medieval Capital Continuing north as you head for the medieval city of Trondheim, whose colorful history is reflected in its handsome civic architecture.
5	Arctic Circle and Lofoten Islands Cross the Arctic Circle to reach the legendary Lofoten Islands, where you can take part in the Lofotr Viking Feast excursion or enjoy an after dinner stroll in Solvaer. Perhaps join the shore excursion to visit the world's first Ice Gallery "Magic Ice" which features dramatically lit ice sculptures and atmospheric music that illustrate tantalising tales about the island and their people.
6	Tromsø, the Gateway to the Arctic Following a relaxing morning on board you arrive mid-afternoon in Tromsø, Norway's arctic capital, to see Northern Light and soak up life high above the Arctic Circle. This is also an ideal location to gain a real taste of the Arctic by joining an optional dog sledging excursion, a truly exhilarating and unforgettable experience.
7	Honningsvåg and the North Cape, Crossing the 71st Parallel After an early call at Hammerfest you arrive in Honningsvåg, the portal to the wonders of the spectacular North Cape, mainland Europe's northernmost point. Evening call at Kjollefjord where you can join the thrilling Lapland snowmobile excursion.
8	Kirkenes and the Snow Hotel Travel to Kirkenes, just a few kilometres from the Russian border. Kirkenes is home to the fantastic Snow Hotel. Transfer for your special Arctic experience to the Snow Hotel, constructed entirely from snow and ice each year and conveniently located for enjoying shore excursion - Husky dog sledging, king crab safari and many others exciting winter activities.
9	Kirkenes - Oslo - Kuala Lumpur via Amsterdam After breakfast, transfer to Airport for flight home.
10	Arrive Home Bringing with you sweet memories and enjoyable moments of your tour share with family and friends.
