

7D5N HOKKAIDO OTARU, SAPPORO, NOBORIBETSU, LAKE TOYA TOUR (JHKHC)

DAY	PROPOSED ITINERARY
D1	KUALA LUMPUR – CHITOSE Overnight flight to Chitose
D2	CHITOSE - NOBORIBETSU – LAKE TOYA (L/D) Upon arrival you will heading to Noboribetsu. First visit to Jigokudani Hell Valley where you can see every steep cliffs and the steam coming off the springs in everywhere. Later visit to Mt. Usuzan Ropeway, a volcano which has erupted four times in the past 100 years. The Usuzan Ropeway brings you close to the volcano's summit. The upper station's observation deck offers panoramic views of Lake Toya and neighboring Showa Shinzan. Then visit to Bear Ranch where you can know more about bear's life. Later check in to Lake Toya hot spring resort.
D3	LAKE TOYA - OTARU - SAPPORO (B/L/D) After breakfast, embark on a journey to the Otaru, a nostalgic port town outside Sapporo, where it is famous for glass, music boxes, cheese cake and chocolate. As soon as you arrive, you will visit the Otaru Canal. Take a stroll down the short and narrow waterway that runs through Otaru city which is adorned with Victorian-style street lamps. Remember to bring your camera along for some beautiful shots! After lunch, we will explore the pretty Kitaichi Glass Museum and the Otaru Music Box Museum. Before back to Sapporo, we will visit the Ishiya Shiroi Koibito Park (Includes admission to the paid-access areas of Shiroi Koibito Park), the chocolate factory and enjoy the collection of chocolate cups from the 19th century and see the process of the much-loved cookies 'Shiroi Koibito'.
D4	SAPPORO (B) After breakfast, visit to Hokkaido Former's Government Building, it is Hokkaido's best known symbol and the red star on its exterior wall is the symbol of the Hokkaido Development Commission Next visit to Sapporo Beer Factory. Then will visit to Odori Park. After will drive pass Clock Tower and Sapporo TV Tower. Next we will move on to Hokkaido Ramen Alley. Later spend some time shopping at Sapporo Underground Shopping Mall - Aurora Town & Pole Town and the Tanukikoji Shopping Arcade. Winter (Dec – Mid Mar) Itinerary change to Snow Experience Day Tour. Summer (End Jun – Mid Aug) Itinerary change to Furano Day Tour.
D5	SAPPORO (B) Free at leisure to explore Sapporo city.
D6	SAPPORO (B/D) Morning proceed to Hokkaido Shrine - one of the most beautiful Japanese temples in the city located in the heart of lovely Maruyama Park. Next we will move on to Sapporo Central Wholesale Market, where you can have a meal of fresh local seafood served over rice (domburi)! Continue your journey to Historic Village of Hokkaido, is an open air museum in the suburbs of Sapporo. It exhibits about 60 typical buildings from all over Hokkaido, dating from the Meiji and Taisho Periods (1868 to 1926), the era when Hokkaido's development was carried out on a large scale. There are four different sections: a town, fishing village, farm village and a mountain village. Then proceed to one of the largest outlet malls in Hokkaido, Mitsui Outlet Park - Sapporo Kitahiroshima sports nearly 130 stores, a large, 650 seat food court and the "Hokkaido Local Farm Village" which offers a wide variety of local specialties and agricultural products.
D7	SAPPORO (Breakfast) Return home from Sapporo.
