<b>D1</b>	<p><b>KUALA LUMPUR – KANSAI OSAKA – NARA - OSAKA (L)</b></p> <p>Leaving from Kuala Lumpur International airport for Kansai.            Upon arrival at Kansai International Airport, transfer to Nara Deer Park, where you will witness hundreds of freely roaming deers.            Photostop at Osaka Castle, one of Japan's most famous landmarks.            Next, enjoy free at leisure time at Shinsaibashi and Dotonbori Street for strolling and shopping around the streets of Osaka.</p>
<b>D2</b>	<p><b>OSAKA – KYOTO – AICHI PREFECTURE (B/L/D)</b></p> <p>After breakfast, depart to Kyoto. Visit Kinkakuji, also known as the Golden Pavillon and an impressive structure built overlooking a large pond. Kinkakuji is a magnificent structure because the top two floors are completely covered with gold leaves.            Photo stop at Gion street, a very famous geisha district.            Visit to Kiyomizu temple, a UNESCO World Cultural Heritage before strolling along Sanenzaka District to have chance to buy some lovely Japanese souvenirs to bring back home.</p> <p><b>** Autumn season (30th Oct – Early Dec) : Kinkakuji replace by Arashiyama foliage            - Stroll along the Togetsukyi Bridge, Arashiyama's most iconic landmark</b></p>
<b>D3</b>	<p><b>AICHI PREFECTURE – HAKONE – MT FUJI REGION (B/D)</b></p> <p>Free time at Gotemba Premium Outlet, Japan's most popular outlet mall which features over 200 stores along with a number of restaurants and a 50 meter high ferris wheel.</p> <p>For Jun to Early of April :            - Entrance to Oshino Hakkai Village, the site of 8 ponds in the Fuji Five Lake region</p> <p>For Mid-April to Late May : Lake Motosu, Shibazakura, a pink carpet produced by nature            - Transfer to Lake Motosu to have Mount Fuji in the background and a pink floral carpet in front</p>
<b>D4</b>	<p><b>MT FUJI REGION – TOKYO (B/L/D)</b></p> <p>Head over to Mt Fuji 5th station, Japan's highest mountain with over 3776 meters and has been worshiped as a sacred mountain with a huge popularity among tourists.            Visit Asakusa Kannon Temple, a Buddhist temple and is one of Tokyo's most colorful and popular temples. Also, enjoy shopping along Nakamise street.            Photo stop at Sky Tower, the second tallest structure in the world and act as a broadcasting as well as an observation tower in Japan.            Drive Pass the beautiful Rainbow Bridge and Imperial Palace.</p> <p>For Late-March to Early of April            - View Sakura at UENO Park – Tokyo's most popular spots for cherry blossom viewing (Hanami)</p>
