Coral Princess blends the exotic (international staff, an elegant Italian restaurant, celebrity-style spa treatments) and the familiar (ubiquitous buffets, poolside umbrella drinks and, yes, bingo). The ship is a vacation destination that offers up a pleasing amount of glitz yet makes passengers feel right at home.

The 91,627-ton ship, built just trim enough to traverse the Panama Canal, accommodates 1,970 passengers and 900 crewmembers. There is a surprising sense of spaciousness onboard, a function of both design and operational efficiency.

DAY	PORT OF CALL	ARRIVAL	DEPARTURE	ACTIVITY
1	Kuala Lumpur / Vancouver Assemble in Airport, fly to the largest metropolitan center in western Canada – Vancouver. Upon arrival, transfer to hotel. Free on own leisure.			
2	Vancouver – Free Day (B) Free at leisure or you may join an optional Victoria City Tour or Butchart Garden Tour.			
3	Vancouver – Kamloops – Clearwater – Valemount (B/L/D) Proceed to Kamloops in the morning and visit a ginseng Farm Enroute, travel along Spahats Creek Provincial Park and visit Spahats Creek Falls and overnight at Valemount.			
4	Valemount – Jasper National Park – Columbia Icefield – Canmore (B/L/Dinner on own) Continue journey to Jasper, passing through Mt Robson, the highest point in the Canadian Rockies. Enroute visit to Athabasca Falls, Columbia Icefield and Glacier Skywalk (the glass-floored platform hangs above 280 metres the Sunwapta Valley on Athabasca Glacier). Then visit Bow Falls in Banff, then head for Canmore overnite.			
5	Canmore – Banff National Park – Lake Louise – Vernon (Breakfast on own/L/D) Proceed to Banff and enjoy early lunch. After this, enjoy Banff Gondola ride at Sulphur Mt. 8 mins ride in four passenger, glass enclosed Gondola and marvel at the unsurpassed view of Banff and Bow Valley up to top of the Sulphur Mt. (7,486 fta.asl) Then leave for Lake Louise, photo taking at Lake Louise, Victoria Glacier. Afternoon depart for Vernon and overnight.			
6	Vernon – Kelowna – Vancouver (B/L/Dinner on own) Moring tour of Kelowna, the orchard area of British Columbia where fruits grown. Visit Lake Okanagan where monster waters claimed sightings of Ogopogo. Visit local Winery and wine tasting and return to Vancouver at late evening.			
7	Vancouver, cruise embarkation (B/Meals on board) Morning free at your own leisure until proceeding to Canadian Palace harbor in the afternoon for boarding the Princess Cruise. The Band with welcome music is waiting right there when the guest step on the Most Luxury Palace of the Sea!	4.30 PM		Cruise check in/ Boarding
8	At Sea (Meals on board) You will sail into the protected Alaska Inside passage, a complex labyrinth of fjords and bays where whales and seas lions find refuge during the summer months. There will be big parties for you to enjoy your day with non-stop supply of good food from morning till evening.

9	Ketchikan, Alaska—Cruise Port (Meals on board) Visitors to Ketchikan will be intrigued by its rich native heritage which includes the world's oldest collection of totem poles at Totem Heritage Center. The Haida, Tlingit and Tsimshian are all a part of the city's colorful history. Ketchikan, with its abundance of salmon, is also a sport-fishing paradise.
